

Karcher CB Flex Suggested Maintenance Schedule

Daily

1. Check all emergency-stop button on basic control panel, wash card/code reader, etc
2. Check self serve operation instructions. Replace damaged or illegible signs.
3. Check detergent container levels - fill or replace as needed
4. Check spray jets for blockage. If needed, screw off jets individually and clean with compressed air. Don't mix them up.
5. Wipe light barriers with a detergent-free soft, damp cloth.
6. Check limit switches for mechanical damage and stable seating.
7. Clean soiled side-brushes, roof brush, and wheel brushes with high-pressure cleaner.
8. Check water supply for rinse and spray circulation
9. Check positioning ramp and light barrier signals

Weekly or every 500 Washes

1. Check condition of wheel, roof and side brush rolls - brush shaft for straightness, brush segments on firm seating, brush for wear and replace if necessary. Replace PE brushes every 15000 - 25000 washes, Carlite brushes every 35000- 45000 washes, and wheel brushes every 15000 washes.
2. Check pipes and hoses for leaks and damage
3. Every 1000 washes, inspection done according to the service manual.

Monthly or every 2000 Washes

1. Clean detergent suction filter in the detergent containers
2. Clean dirt catcher filter with fresh water

Yearly or every 10000 Washes

1. Inspection done according to the service manual.
